COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS- SPECIAL MEETING
June 14th, 2010

Mayor Harold Stickney called to order a special meeting of the Common Council. Present at roll call were Councilpersons Pischke, Murphey, Reetz, and Schleining. The Pledge of Allegiance was stated.

CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

No conflicts of interest were stated.

ELECTION CANVASS

The Council reviewed the Election Board Recap Sheet, the Poll Book, and the Duplicate Tally Sheet and all balanced. The official canvass stated the votes for Gary Lipp 119 and Patty Ressler 62, votes for Corbin Herman 155 and Terry Reetz 65, votes for James Hattervig 79, Jim Frank 34, and Barbara Hanson 31, votes for Liquor Store Closure Yes 349 and No 218.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Councilperson Murphey moved to go into and out of executive session at 6:18 due to contract negotiations with the Finance Officer, Rex Harris, Gary Lipp, Corbin Herman, James Hattervig, Pat Walker, Dave Thom, Jason Petik, Tim Sughrue, and Glen Bryant present. Seconded by Councilperson Pischke, the motion unanimously carried. The session adjourned at 7:15. Councilperson Murphey moved to bring a proposal from Regional Health and Community Health Services Board to the public with a presentation at the June 21st Council meeting, with a public hearing at the July 5th Council meeting, Seconded by Councilperson Schleining, the motion unanimously carried.

MULTI-DEPARTMENT ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT / CLEANING BID

Councilperson Murphey moved to approve moving Kim Conwell into the Multi-Department Administrative Assistant position effective once the Liquor Store has closed at the probationary rate of \$11.52. Starting June 20th Kim will work 30 hours at the Liquor Store and 10 hours cleaning as part of her new position until such time the Liquor Store closes. Seconded by Councilperson Schleining, the motion carried with Councilperson Pischke, Murphey and Schleining voting yes while Councilperson Reetz voted no. Councilperson Schleining moved to reject the cleaning bid received. Seconded by Councilperson Murphey, the motion unanimously carried.

With no further business, Mayor Stickney adjourned the meeting at 7:26 p.m.
