ORDINANCE NO. 809

An Ordinance entitled An Ordinance Amending Title 8 Health and Safety, Chapter 12 Garbage Collection and Disposal, Section 8.12.130 Garbage collection to paragraph C where there shall be charged by the city, upon passage and publication of the ordinance codified in this chapter as provided by law to wit:

- C. Each residential customer shall be billed and collected monthly the charge of nineteen dollars and twenty cents (\$19.20) for garbage disposal.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed. Should any section or part of this Ordinance be determined to be invalid, the same shall not invalidate the remaining section(s) of this Ordinance.

Provide motorcycle parking and improve public safety during motorcycle rally


Duration of occupancy: PERMANENT TEMPORARY If temporary, give the estimated date of removal or completion:
